For today’s program, our speaker was Allison Goodwin, Programs Manager with the Redwood Empire Foodbank. She was accompanied by her colleague, Itzul Gutierrez, also a Programs Manager for the Redwood Empire Food Bank. Allison pointed out that they operate from here to the Oregon border,



a very large territory indeed. They serve 82K people per year. They have 12 different program models. Their funding comes primarily from individuals, and they distribute about 1million dollars' worth of produce per year.
