Announcing the 2013 fall "Fast for Hope" delegation to Nicaragua, September 14th thru September 23rd. If you have always wanted to be a part of a ROTARY delegation to a foreign country, but don't have the time to be part of a FSE team, this team could be the answer. The team will be led by Bev Driscoll of the Stillwater Club who has made multiple trips to Nicaragua and you will be guided by the experienced team, Escuela AKF. The delegation will be capped at approximately 12 so early application is encouraged. Application forms are available on the Fast for Hope link on the website.

District 5960 ROTARIANS, their spouses, significant others and friends are welcome to apply. You do not need to be able to speak Spanish, interpreters will be provided, although on a group basis, not an individual basis. Some knowledge of Spanish (i.e. useful phrases) would be beneficial in communicating with the people you meet.

So far, District 5960 has sent 13 delegations to Nicaragua. Not one delegate has visited Nicaragua who has not thought it was a life changing experience. If you are willing to risk stepping out of your comfort zone, be assured that you will be a changed person and your worldview expanded.

ROTARIANS know that an RI Convention will be a sociable experience, but those planning to travel to Lisbon for the 2013 convention, June 23-26, have even more reason to expect an amicable welcome.
