Some ROTARY History:

- *Through the years, ROTARY has become involved in many community projects, but perhaps one of the most remembered is the Christmas program which was held each year for the children of the State School. It included reindeer and Santa Clause who all came to Owatonna via the Rock Island Line.
- *A Thanksgiving project was conducted for a number of years. ROTARIANS took turns taking a basket of food to an elderly woman, and after her death, it was discovered that she was worth better than one-half million dollars!
- *At the 50th anniversary program of the ROTARY Club, Dr. A.J. Olson, a long-time ROTARY member spoke on the beginnings of the ROTARY and its history.
- *1980 marked the year RI voted to extend membership to woman. Owatonna inducted its first women members in 1987 including Betsy Lindgren and Sabra Otteson. Sabra was the first third generation family member to become a ROTARIAN at the Owatonna Club. She remains that today. Her grandfather, E.K. Whiting was a charter member of the club
- *In 1980, one of the ROTARY programs centered around mobile telephones. Sabra served as president of this club in 1993-1994. Her presidential term followed that of Sharon West.
- *Up until the mid seventies, programs were assigned to individual ROTARIANS. There was a monthly chairman named and it was his responsibility to make sure there were programs for each meeting. The plan wasn't entirely successful and many times a meeting would be held and no program had been scheduled. That was when ROTARIAN Todd Hale took over the program scheduling which he continues to do today. It was initially an easy task because he met so many interesting people through his work at KRFO and they were booked as speakers. Programs are now booked weeks, if not months ahead.
- *The Owatonna ROTARY club "welcome" message on I-35 exit as highway 14 is spelled out in a hedge that is made up of 150 individual shrubs. The message is approximately 25 by 100 feet and was made possible by the Owatonna ROTARY club which donated funds for installation of the living bill board
