ROTARIANS Tom Effertz and Dave Effertz extend an invitation to all ROTARIANS to stop by the Open House of TPS Insurance on 18th Street this Friday, October 26 from 1:00-5:00 p.m. The occasion marks the 100th anniversary of their insurance agency in Owatonna. Here's a bit of history on this business. Cline Tincher started the agency in 1912 in Owatonna and operated as C.A. Tincher. The original office was located in City Hall. It then moved to another downtown location. The first company represented was United States Fidelity and Guaranty. Their State Agent was a gentleman by the name of Thiemer and for awhile the agency was known as Thiemer and Tincher. Oscar Peterson came to the agency during the Depression and the office was moved into what is now the Wells Fargo Bank building. At that time, Mr. Thiemer left the agency which represented all mutual companies after the depression.

Ty Sincock came to Owatonna and joined the agency in 1947 after experience as a field representative for Safeco Insurance Company. He stayed with the agency until 1977. They had several downtown locations during this time and were in the building next to the Armory across from Federated since 1960.

Andy Wolf joined the agency in 1968 and purchased the interest of Oscar Peterson. ROTARIAN Thomas G. Effertz joined the agency in 1975 and purchased the interest of Ty Sincock. Mr. Effertz then purchased the interest of Mr. Wolf in 1983. Tom's wife, Terri, and Tom's brother, George joined the agency in 1984 and ROTARIAN Dave Effertz joined the agency in 1999. Current officers are Tom Effertz, Chairman of the Board, Dave Effertz, President, George Effertz, Vice President.

DID YOU KNOW? The Owatonna ROTARY Club was begun on April 10, 1922 by fourteen men. One of the most remembered community projects of the Owatonna ROTARY Club was the Christmas program held each year for the children of the State School. It included reindeer and Santa who all came to Owatonna via the Rock Island Line.

ROTARY NEWS

ROTARY'S Pakistan Polio-Plus Committee partnered with Coca Cola Beverages Pakistan to promote polio eradication. Coca-Cola Pakistan printed polio-awareness messages on more than 70 million bottle labels and incorporated "End Polio Now" ringtones at its call stations across the country. In addition, the company will place permanent messages on 250,000 Coke coolers that are being distributed throughout Pakistan and it will promote National Immunization Days on billboards. Coca-Cola has also agreed to provide sponsored vans as needed to transport polio vaccine and to help supply clean water in high-risk districts to reduce diarrhea in children.
