



Our Patrol Division

The Uniformed Patrol Division is the largest division in the Bastrop Police Department. The primary purpose of the patrol division is the protection of life and property and the promotion of the safety and welfare of the general public. Patrol works 12-hour shifts starting and ending at 6:00AM and 6:00PM. Patrol officers are off every second weekend.



Criminal Investigations Division

Three (3) detectives and their supervisor are responsible for the investigation of "routine" calls to the most "complex" calls.

They have an average of forty (40) to fifty (50) active open investigations at any one time in addition to being responsible for managing anywhere from one hundred fifteen (115) to one hundred twenty (120) cases at any one time.
