- * CREATES AN ANTI-BULLING CULTURE.
- * CREATES OVERALL ACADEMIC IMPROVEMENT THROUGH A POSITIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT
- * INCREASE (DOUBLE TO TRIPLE) STUDENT VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION.
- * CAUSES A LARGE (200+%) INCREASE IN PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT.

HOW IS THIS ACCOMPLISHED?

THE K THROUGH 5 STUDENTS ARE TAUGHT THE IMPORTANCE IN LIFE OF THE FOLLOWING CHARACTER TRAITS/VALUES:

* RESPECT *CONFIDENCE

* FRIENDLINESS *HONESTY

* TOLERANCE *SERVICE

* RESPONSIBILITY *COMPASSION

* DISCIPLINE *PERSEVERANCE

AND THE FOUR - WAY TEST

EACH CHARACTER TRAIT/VALUE HAS 20 - 10 MINUTE LESSONS SUPPORTING IT. ONE 10 MINUTE LESSON IS TAUGHT EACH SCHOOL DAY. AFTER 20 CLASS DAY LESSONS, AN ASSEMBLY TAKES PLACE AT THE SCHOOL AND AN AWARD/MEDAL IS GIVEN TO A STUDENT FROM EACH GRADE AND CLASSROOM THAT BEST REPRESENTS THAT SPECIFIC TRAIT/VALUE. THIS 'EARLY KNIGHTS ASSEMBLY" (10 EACH YEAR) IS IN FRONT OF ALL THE SCHOOL'S STUDENTS AND FACULTY. PARENTS AND FAMILY OF THE AWARD/MEDAL STUDENT ARE ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND AND SHARE IN THE EXPERIENCE AND SHOW THEIR APPROVAL OF THE AWARD/MEDAL STUDENTS ACCOMPLISHMENT.
