Although all participants will certainly have a good time eating pancakes and sausage and talking with Santa again this year on Saturday, December 12, the **primary objective** of the "Breakfast with Santa" program **is to help selected kids and families in our community** at Christmas. In 2014, local business sponsorships, contributions from Rotarians, friends, families and neighbors plus a very generous grant from a charitable foundation provided the financial support and resources to help make Christmas a lot brighter for the 166 kids (55 families) that were beneficiaries of our "Breakfast with Santa" program last year. Also, we were able to provide financial assistance to the Jarrell UMC "Out-Reach Project" as well as purchase gift card packages for 20 GISD teenagers served by The Georgetown Project's "NEST" (a day shelter providing supportive services for teenagers qualified as "homeless").

This year's goal to provide gifts for 175 kids (60 families), support Jarrell UMC and help 25 teenagers can only be achieved with continued financial support and sponsorships from the business community and individual donors.
