Your help this year made Christmas a lot brighter for many children and families in Georgetown, 35 teenagers served by "The NEST" (program managed by The Georgetown Project) plus many more additional kids and families served by the Jarrell UMC annual Christmas Outreach

BWS funds provided envelopes containing gift cards for a restaurant, movie tickets and other general shopping for the "NEST" teenagers. Selected families, who accepted the invitation to participate, SHOPPED at Kohl's for clothing and toys (\$100 for each selected BWS child) and those families also received grocery gift cards (ranging from \$150 to \$275) to help provide a special family Christmas meal. Kohl's Cash generated from BWS SHOPPING was re-gifted to The LOCKER (both Georgetown and Jarrell) along with additional cash from BWS funds.

Sun City Rotary Club's 19th "Breakfast with Santa" (much, much more than just "BREAKFAST") has gradually increased from a total of 10 children (4 Georgetown families) to the current level (direct and indirect help for over 200 kids). GISD identified this year's BWS kids and families (from Purl Elementary School). Selected parents/quardians actually did the Christmas shopping for their kids (with assistance from Rotarians, friends and Kohl's Associates-in-Action volunteers) and were provided with wrapping materials for their selected gifts. "Breakfast with Santa 2019" concluded with a pancake and sausage breakfast at the San Gabriel Community Center on Saturday, December 14. Georgetown Firefighters and families, Rotarians and volunteers cooked the meal and served 970 children and adults from our community and area. Santa also made an early visit to Georgetown that morning (delivered by the Ladies on Wheels Motorcycle Club) and was available for consultation and complimentary photos with the kids.
