She talked about the tremendous growth in Jarrell ISD, both in student population and in staff. The development of Sonterra, east of I-35, is mainly responsible for this increase.

A \$42 million bond election will be presented to voters in May. This will allow for funds to build a second elementary school and a new middle school. Forty percent of Sun City lies in the Jarrell ISD.
