Our speaker was Ken Anderson, who was introduced by Bill Miller. Ken served as DA for Williamson County before becoming a judge.

Judge Anderson related a story behind the story of why he wrote a book about former governor Dan Moody. Unable to find any book written about Dan Moody, Ken decided to write one.

He told us how Dan Moody successfully prosecuted Klan members in 1923-24, which helped to destroy their political power in Texas.

(Dan Moody was born in 1893 in Taylor, TX, and was elected the youngest governor in Texas in 1927. As governor, he was known as a reformer and an opponent of the KKK. He died in 1966 and is buried in the Texas State Cemetery in Austin.)
