The Endowment Fund

Our Sun City Rotary Club established a Permanent Endowment Fund at Chisolm Trail Communities Foundation in June of 2010 with \$25,000, the bulk of which was donated by **Graham** and **Carolyn Holloway**. By the 31st of March, 2017, additional donations and fund investment earnings had grown to \$106,290 with \$95,151 being corpus (donated dollars and \$11,139 unexpended fund earnings. Fund investments have earned \$31,539 of which \$20,400 has been expended by the
