Dick Will introduced Florence High School's Ag Teacher, Bobby Rosenbusch. Bobby Rosenbusch has been Florence High School's Ag teacher since 1995, and plans to retire. He will hand over the reins next year to Joe Barber.

This is not just a normal Ag/FFA course that students at Florence High attend, but an advanced life skill class that opens great hands on opportunity for students Food Agriculture, Agriculture Science & Technology. This high school has its own Meat processing & Retail Market that is opened to the public during the school calendar year. The Ag department offers advanced knowledge classes on meat processing certification, career specializations & licensing & pre-employment labs. They learn every skill that is needed to follow a career in the food processing/meat industry. This is the only school in the State that has a Retail Meat Market. The students also attend different contest that helps them earn scholarships for college. By the year 2000, $\frac{1}{2}$ Million dollars in Scholarships were given to students. While learning to apply sciences they also learn how to put those skills to use in the retail Market.

The Meat Market is located at, 401 FM 970, in Florence. Even if they are only open during school hours & days, it is well worth your time to get Prime Quality meats. Their business hours are Monday-Friday, 8:30-3:00PM. They are closed for lunch from 11:30-12:30 each day.
