The Rotary Club of Tamazunchale in Central Mexico submitted a matching grant to the Foundation to build ecological stoves for the indigenous people (Nahautl Indians) of the area. The Rotary Clubs of North Padre Island and Georgetown-Sun City are partners in this matching grant.

I visited the area during Spring Break to see the project and learn more about it firsthand. My family and I went to the indigenous communities and saw the wood burning ecological stove in use. A woman even made us an omelet cooked on a banana leaf instead of a pan!

I believe the project in an excellent example of improving the daily lives and health of children and adults there and am proud that our club is involved in this project. I spent three days in Tamazunchale accompanied by Rotarians. At their regular Rotary meeting I was presented with five of their club banners. The Rotarians were very hospitable and eager to show me the details and benefits of the stove project. I would love to present details to the club in the near future.
