Your financial contributions this year made Christmas a lot brighter for fifty families with students at Frost Elementary School in Georgetown, thirty-five teenagers served by "The NEST" (program managed by The Georgetown Project) plus many more additional kids and families assisted by the Jarrell UMC annual Christmas Outreach Project as well as members of our community served by The Caring Place in Georgetown.

Frost Elementary School families, identified and selected by GISD, who accepted the invitation to participate this year, received grocery gift cards to help provide a special family Christmas meal while "NEST" teenagers received envelopes containing gift cards for restaurants and movie tickets. The LOCKER (Georgetown High Schools plus Jarrell High School) received BWS cash and gift cards to support their programs.

Sun City Rotary Club's 21st "Breakfast with Santa" has gradually increased from an initial total of 10 children (4 Georgetown families) to the current level (direct and indirect help for well over 200 kids). Hopefully, in 2022 we will be able to resume our traditional BWS assistance for selected families (primary BWS focus) as well as breakfast and Santa's visit to Georgetown for consultation and complimentary photos with the kids.
