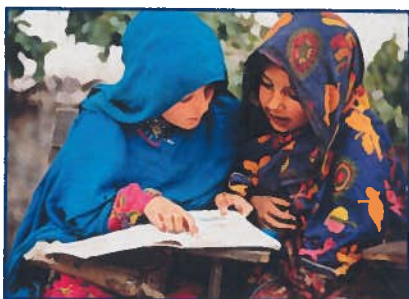

**2nd** High ethical standards in business and professions; recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's



occupation as an opportunity to serve society.

**3rd** The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life.

**4th** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.
