District 7030 consists of 67 Clubs spread over 14 countries in the Caribbean with 2000 Rotarians. Two of those Clubs are in Grenada and tonight we acknowledge its Independence Day, celebrated last Sunday, 7th February by making our International Toast to the Rotary Club of Grenada East.

Grenada is part of the Lesser Antilles Island chain which runs north off the coast of South America. It was occupied as a French colony in the 17th Century and ceded to Britain a hundred years later. It achieved independence in 1974 but was the subject of political insurrection in 1983 which was ended by an invasion led by the United States under President Ronald Reagan when the less socialist government was restored.

The population is only 111,000; the Capital is St. George's and the principal economic activity, not surprisingly, is tourism. The Club was Chartered in 1977 in District 7030 which covers 122 Clubs in 17 countries in the eastern Caribbean and the north coast of South America. It has 18 Members led by **President Charlie Hossle**.

One of the Club's continuing projects is the conduct of eye clinics in the community in conjunction with a Club from Louisiana in the US. Would you please be upstanding in recognition of the Independence Day of Grenada and toast the President and Members of the Rotary Club of Grenada East.
