Yesterday was the Independence Day of the **Republic of Estonia**.

Estonia is located on the Gulf of Finland with Finland on the north side, Russia to the east and Latvia to the south.

Given its location it has over time been part of the kingdoms and empires of Sweden, Denmark, Poland, Russia and Germany as well as controlling neighbouring territories itself.

The Country had been occupied by Russia before the First World War and with the Revolution of 1917 it declared itself independent on 24th of February, 1918. It then had to fight wars of independence against both Russian and German remnants.

Stalin claimed Estonia as part of the Russian-German non-aggression pact in 1940 and killed or deported all resistance. Then when the Germans over ran it a year later the Holocaust was visited on the Jews and others. It is estimated that a quarter of the Country's population was killed as non-combatants during the war.

Estonia became a Soviet Socialist Republic and was finally able to re-establish itself in August 1991 as an independent Republic with its pre-war constitution.

Today it has a population of about 1.3 million and is a Member of the European Union, NATO and the OECD.

The Capital is Tallinn, on the north coast opposite Helsinki. It has 433 000 residents and 6 of the country's 14 Rotary Clubs in District 1420 which also covers Finland.

Rotary was established in Estonia in 1930 with the Rotary Club Tallinn which survived for 10 years until the Russian invasion. Its original Charter was revived in 1991 with the collapse of the Soviet Union. It now has 41 Members led by President Margus Allikmaa.

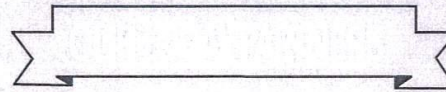
HOW TO NOMINATE A MATE

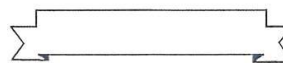

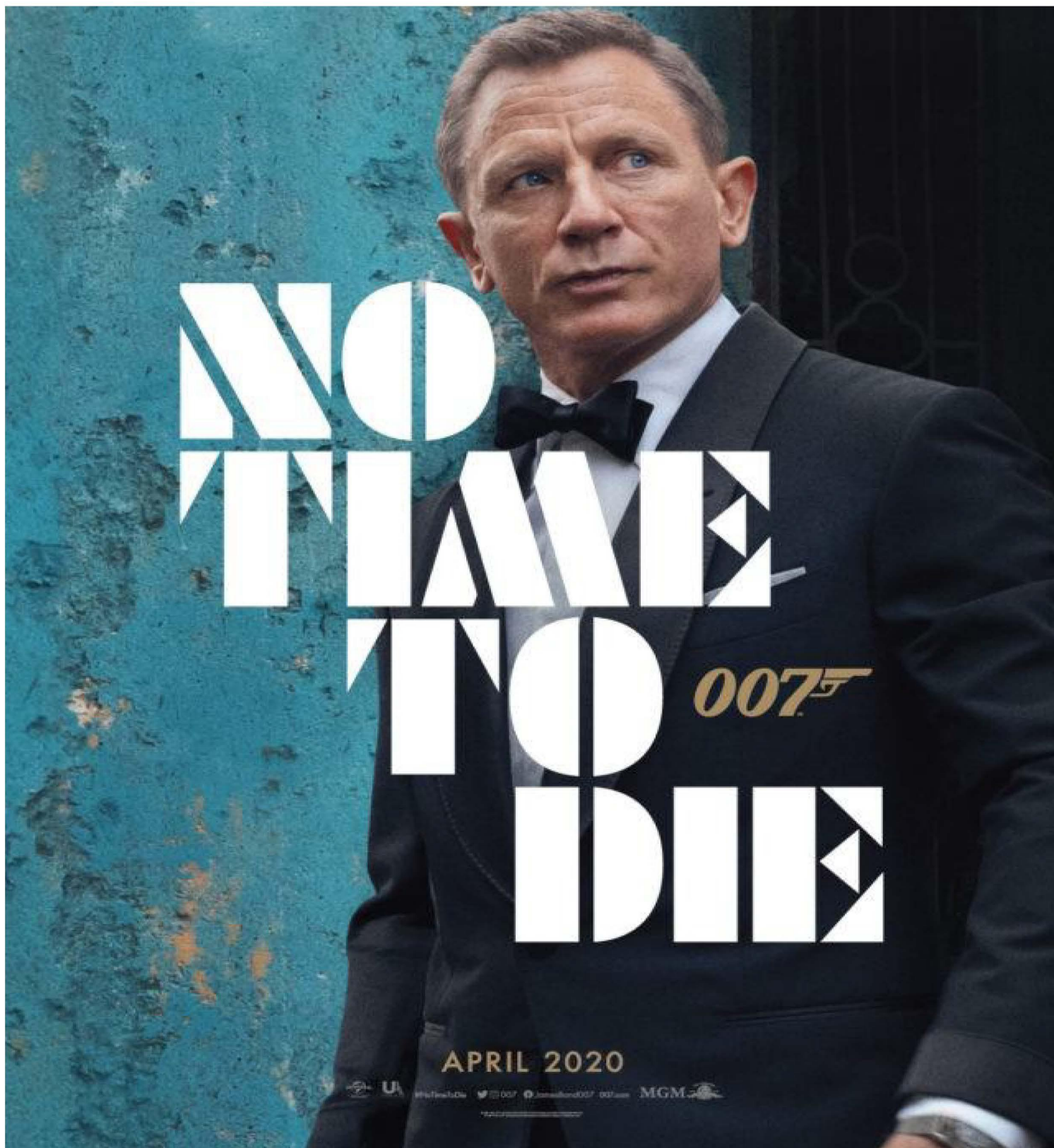
