Some sessions that provided huge amounts of knowledge and allowed Lily to progress her capabilities included Leadership in Action, HBDI, debating, resilience, mental health, ethics in leadership.

Leadership utilized tools which allowed participants to learn practical leadership skills. The HBDI session is based on research on how the brain thinks and communicates. Participants were split into four colours with each colour displaying different characteristics.

Debating was a very challenging session. The Four Way Test was used as a debating tool.

Lily found the Mental Health session really helpful and was provided with strategies to improve and practice mental health.

The Ethics Session was Lily's favourite session and she enjoyed seeing the opinions of other participants on topics including social media, religion, economics, politics.

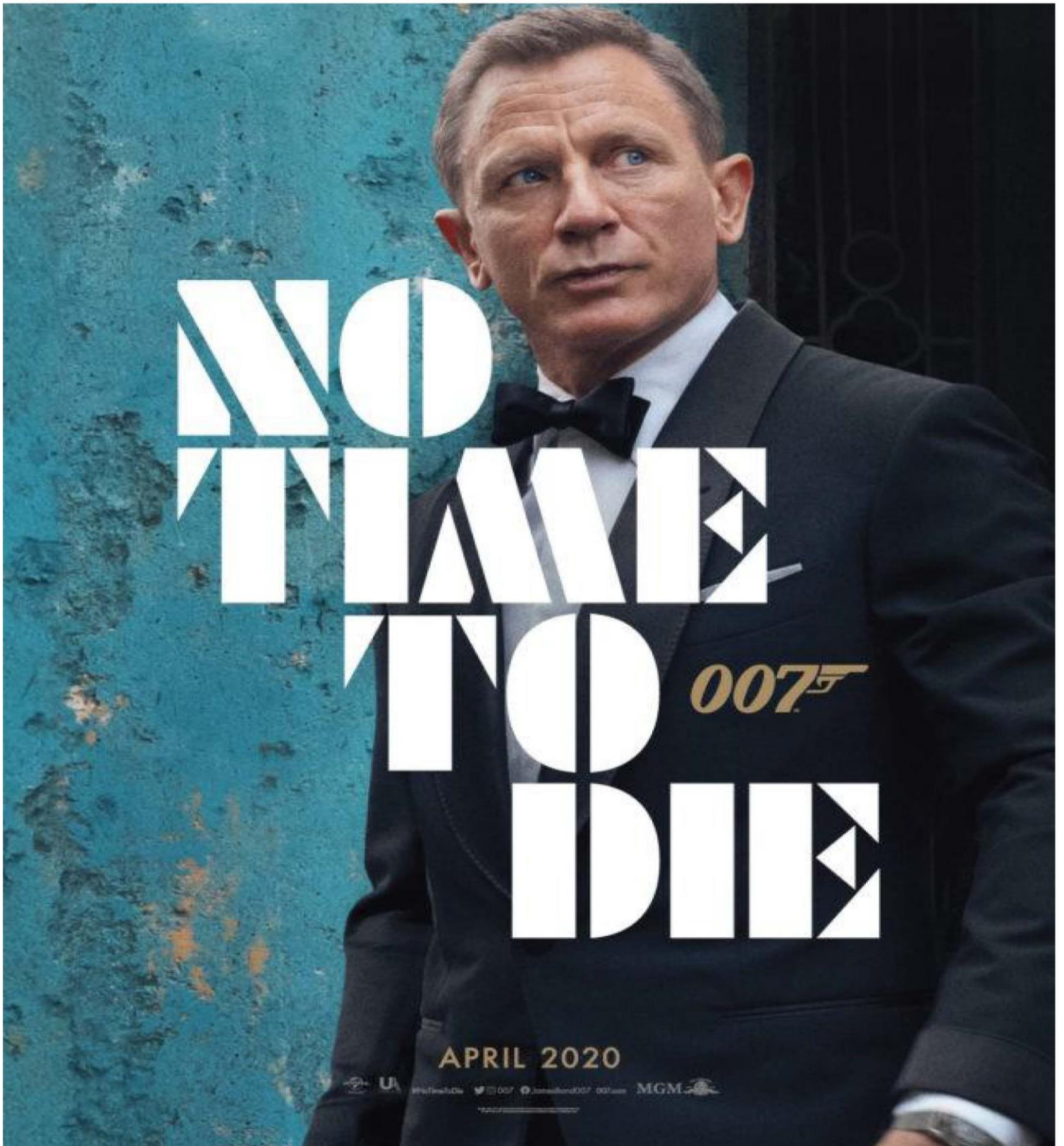
