This coming Friday, the 15th of September is the anniversary of the end of the Federal Republic of Central America when they declared their independence from the Spanish Empire in 1821.


Those federated states became Costa Rica, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua and Guatemala. Mexico, to their North, declared its independence on the following day and they all celebrate their Independence Days this week.

Last Friday an earthquake of magnitude 8.2 struck the area followed by the remains of Hurricane Katia. We heard of the damage to Mexico but little of the effects on Guatemala which also sustained loss of life and severe damage to buildings and towns.

The City of Tecun Uman is on the border with Mexico near the Pacific coast in the north west corner of Guatemala near the epicentre of the earthquake.

The Rotary Club of Guatemala North is located in Tecun Uman and is no doubt playing its part in the recovery from these combined disasters.

The Club was Chartered in District 4250 in 1987 and has 34 Members led by **President Beatriz Arroyave**. In recognition of the Independence Days of the Central American countries and in sympathy with their people affected by the earthquake and hurricane over the past week would you please be upstanding and toast the President and Members of the Rotary Club of Guatemala North.
