Pakistan gained its independence on 14th August, 1947 after a violent period of partition of East and West Pakistan from India.

6½ million Muslims moved to West Pakistan and 4.7 million Hindus moved into India. It was the largest migration in human history. The border with India is still disputed in Kashmir and East Pakistan split to become Bangladesh in 1971.

Pakistan has a population of 213 million and continues to have a turbulent political environment.

Imran Khan, the legendary cricketer well known to us, leads the largest opposition party and resumed his seat in the National Assembly just yesterday.

Hyderabad is the fourth largest city in Pakistan located in the south near Karachi. The Rotary Club of Hyderabad Sindh was Chartered in 1938 in District 3271 and has 24 Members led by President Iqbal Memon. They continue to work with End Polio Now to eradicate polio from their Country.
