



Presentation:

Robert De Jongh recently learned of a local worthy project being run in the Southern Highlands by a local retired teacher, Trish Reinberger. Robert gave an informative and interesting presentation of Trish's work.

Trish has been volunteering in Vanuatu for the past six years and was recently asked by a school principal for help with school uniforms for the students. A team of women from the Southern Highlands have made hundreds of uniforms and donated them to schools in Vanuatu. Trish has also begun training local women in Vanuatu to sew, and they are now making the uniforms and being supported to set up cottage industry businesses.

Trish is hoping to raise \$3000 to purchase 10 new machines and 2 overlockers to donate the program in Vanuatu. Trish would also like support to renovate the building they use in Vanuatu and help to build a library for the local High School on Espirito Santo.
