Tonight we will hear from our new exchange student Veerle who will talk to us about her home town Elst in Holland so I won't pre-empt her talk.

This is an opportunity for us to thank her Sponsor Club, the Rotary Club of Elst Over-Betuwe for sending her to us for the next year.

The Club serves the 22 000 people of the city of Elst and other places in the world, especially Africa. Earlier this year they organised an event called *Walking for Water* where Year 7 and 8 Primary School children walked 6 km carrying 6 litres of water in a back pack - just like many African children do every day to bring water to their families.

The event raised 18 000 Euros which, with a Matching Grant from the Rotary Foundation went to providing water tanks and toilets to villages in Ethiopia.

Some of the 60 Members of the Club have recently had their hands on renovating a home in Elst for an elderly sick member of the community.

*And* they found and sent Veerle to us on Global Youth Exchange.
