Eritrea is a country of 5 million people on the Red Sea coast of the Horn of Africa with Sudan to its west, Djibouti to its south east and Ethiopia to its south.

It is believed that this area, at the top end of the Rift Valley was the seat of the origins of *Homo sapiens* so it has been occupied by humans for a very long time.

It was part of a Christian kingdom including part of Ethiopia from the 2nd century AD. It became part of the Italian Empire in 1890 until Italy left it in 1942 and it became a British Army Protectorate and then self governing associated with Ethiopia in 1952.

In 1962 Ethiopia attempted to re-annex Eritrea and 30 years of war followed.

Eritrea declared its independence on 24th May, 1991 and it formally became a state on 24th May, 1993.

Eritrea celebrates its 25th anniversary of independence on Thursday.

Its capital Asmara is a city of 800 000 which sits at 2300 metres above sea level near the edge of the escarpment of the Rift Valley.

The Rotary Club of Asmara it the only one in the Country. It was Chartered in District 9212 which also covers Kenya, South Sudan and Ethiopia, in 1997 and has 32 Members.
