The Republic of Djibouti celebrated its Independence Day yesterday, commemorating the achievement of independence from France in 1977 by a peaceful vote of its citizens.

Djibouti is in the north east corner of Africa at the bend between the Red Sea and the Gulf of Aden. It is bordered by Eritrea to the west, Ethiopia to the south and west and Somalia to the east and it is a dry to very dry land.

From the early days of Islam in the 6th Century AD it was a sultanate which became a French colony in the late 19th Century.

Nowadays its population is about 830 000 but most live in poverty. A significant part of its national income is from the lease of military bases to foreign countries including a large US naval Base, a French Foreign Legion Base, Japan's only overseas base and even the Chinese are building their first foreign base there.

Rotary District 9220 includes 62 Clubs covering Djibouti and the Indian Ocean Islands as we found when we toasted a Club in the Seychelles two weeks ago.

Tonight we toast the Rotary Club of Djibouti Mer Rouge - Djibouti Red Sea -which was Chartered in 2010 and has a growing Membership of 29 led by President Abdoulsalam Osman Ali.

The Club ran a breast and cervical cancer screening program in April and is very active in women's and children's health issues and the End Polio Now Program.

Permaculture based on 6 zones around the home


