Thursday is the anniversary of the day in 1990 after the fall of communism in Europe when Croatia formed its first free parliament after the Second World War. It was declared as Statehood Day but the celebration was changed the following year to the end of June when independence from Yugoslavia was declared.

Four years of the vicious Balkans Civil War against Serbia followed until in October 1995 the Croatians finally achieved sovereignty and independence.

Split is a city on the southern Adriatic coast of Croatia - the Dalmatian Coast - a beautiful tourist resort area.

It was a Greek colony in the 3rd century BC and the holiday home of Roman Emperor Diocletian who had a palace built there. Its ruins are part of the tourist attractions. Over the centuries since, the city's ownership changed many times between Venice, Italy, Austria and the Austro-Hungarian and French empires.

Split has a population of 350 000 and is the home of the Rotary Club of Split which was Chartered in 1993 in Rotary District 1913.

President Josip Mrklic leads 45 Members in this very active Club in service to the community.
