Today is the **Independence Day of Belarus** the central European country formerly known as Byelo-Russia or White Russia.

It celebrates the day of liberation of Belarus from the Germans in 1944 but of course they became a Soviet Socialist Republic immediately after the war and didn't achieve real sovereignty until the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1990.

Belarus has a population of 9½ million surrounded by Russia to the east and its Kaliningrad enclave to the west, Ukraine to the south, Poland to the west and Lithuania and Latvia to the north.

The capital is Minsk, a city of 2 million founded in 1067 – the year after William the Conqueror left Normandy. The **Rotary Club of Minsk** is one of 3 in Belarus in District 2232. It was Chartered in 1994 and has 15 Members led by **President Igor Vorobiev**.
