Gdansk Harbour



Today is the National Day of Poland. The modern Republic of Poland was formed after the collapse of the communist regime in 1989.

Its second President was Lech Walensa who had been an electrician at the shipyards in Gdansk on the Baltic Sea coast. He had been a union organiser and was arrested several times by the government as a trouble maker.

He co-founded Solidarity which staged long running strikes in the ship yards and finally brought down the government which precipitated the collapse of communist states throughout eastern Europe.

He was President from 1990 to 1995 and was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1983 for his non-violent resistance to the oppressive regime.

Gdansk is a city of 460 000 in a tri-city urban area of some 1.4 million and the city has a history going back over a thousand years.

The Rotary Club of Gdansk-Centrum was Chartered only this year in District 2230 which has 123 clubs in Poland and its neighbours, Belarus and Ukraine.

The 22 Members are led by President Joanna Jaroszyk.

The Club has already made its mark in raising funds and sending food parcels to elderly people suffering hardship and starvation in eastern Ukraine and in supporting the Foundation for Children of Pomerania with disabilities.
