On Sunday, 21st August the Rotary Club of Rieti, a town about 100km from Rome ran a very successful Walk for Life Telethon as a fund raising activity.

Three days later the region was rocked by the 6.2 level earthquake which destroyed Amatrice, Norcia and many other villages in the mountains a little further east in the middle of Italy.

Around 300 people are confirmed dead, many are injured and an unknown number are still missing in the rubble.

You will have seen an email from the Chairman of ShelterBox Australia, Past District Governor Rowley Tompsett last weekend advising that the Rotary Club of Rieti, being the nearest Club to the area has been assisting a ShelterBox Disaster Response Team in assessing the immediate needs and are now delivering ShelterBoxes to the survivors who have lost everything.

The Rotary Club of Rieti was Chartered in 1952 in District 2080. It is one of 88 Clubs in the District and has 62 Members led by President Attilio Ferri.
