### International Toast - Brian Ritson

Mustafa Kamal Ataturk established the Republic of Turkey from the remnants of the Ottoman Empire on 29th October, 1923 and the Turkish people celebrated Republic Day last week.

Since the First World War and the shared experience of Gallipoli, Australia and Turkey have enjoyed a special kinship. Ataturk's words of comfort and respect to the mothers of our fallen soldiers cemented the relationship.

The largest city and former capital is Istanbul with a population of 5.3 million. The capital was moved to Ankara with the establishment on the Republic in 1923.

The Rotary Club of Istanbul-Adalar is one of 58 Clubs in Istanbul. It was Chartered in 1985 in District 2420 and has 21 Members led by President Aylin Pelenk.
