Today is the National Day of Swaziland celebrating independence from the British Protectorate in 1968.

The country was a kingdom long before becoming a protectorate of Britain after the Boer War. It is mostly mountainous and landlocked surrounded by South Africa and bordering Mozambique of 17 000 square kilometres and 1.1 million people. Its Capital city is Mbabane.

Matsapha is a small town in the centre of Swaziland not far from the Capital.

The Rotary Club of Matsapha was Chartered in 2005 and is one of 5 clubs in Swaziland and 79 in District 9400 which also covers northern South Africa, Botswana and Mozambique.

The Club has only 11 Members led by President Sifisio Sithole but they are active in a Rotary literacy program which buys and collects and distributes books to school children.




