Every Rotarian has the privilege of seeking qualified Rotary club members. Bringing in new members expands the ability of our club to serve others. As you know, membership in Rotary is by invitation only, and until approval is granted, prospective members should not be informed that they have been proposed for membership.

The process begins when a current member submits the name of a prospective member to the board of directors using this form. The board ensures the qualifications of that person and votes within 30 days to approve or disapprove the proposed member. If approved, the name and classification of the proposed member is published to the club. If no objection is received within seven days of that time, the proposed member can then join the club.

New Member Guidelines Georgetown Lunch Rotary

Procedure

- Candidate should attend at least one meeting prior to being proposed for membership.
- Application to be filled out by Member and Candidate and returned to the Membership Director.
- Membership Director will meet with candidate to discuss financial responsibilities. Candidate will sign forms agreeing to these guidelines.
- Completed application will then be presented to the Board.
- Once approved by the Board, the general membership will be notified in writing at the next available meeting.

Fees

- One time admission fee of \$100.00.
- Quarterly dues: \$200.00
 - Dues include \$25 per quarter Paul Harris Sustaining Membership in the Rotary International Foundation which is optional but encouraged for all Rotarians.
- Additional fund raising expenses include:
 - Each member is expected to support the Shag Festival (proceeds fund research for Alzheimer's cure and Rotary service projects) by purchasing 10 Shag Festival tickets at \$20 each (\$200) in April. *Rotarians are urged to sell their tickets to the public and recover all or most of this expense.*

Participation

- To be a Rotarian you must give of your time and talents.
- Attendance at the weekly Tuesday meeting is a benefit of Rotary, including the fellowship and learning about Club and Rotary District activities. A member must attend or make up at least 50% of the Club's regular meetings each half of the year.
- You can maintain your attendance levels by making up at another Rotary Club meeting, participating in club service projects and activities, attending monthly board or committee meetings, or Rotary district activities. Time span is two weeks prior, if you plan to be out, or two weeks after you return.
- A member may not miss or fail to make up four consecutive meetings.
