RULE OF 85 ATTENDANCE EXEMPTION

The Rule of 85 is an exemption from the regular attendance requirements stated in the club's by-laws:

Section 2(b) the age of the member is 65 and above and the aggregate of the member's years of age and years of membership in one or more clubs is 85 years or more and the member has notified the club secretary in writing of the member's desire to be excused from attendance and the board has approved.

Upon Board approval, the member is responsible for:

- District dues (currently \$33 every 6 months)
- Rotary International dues (currently \$27 every 6 months)
- Any other fees mandated by Rotary International and/or District 7770
- Club fundraising project participation assessments (such as the Shag Festival)
- Cost of meals when attending meetings

Rule of 85 members are strongly encouraged to:

- Support the Rotary Foundation with a contribution to maintain the club's Every Rotarian, Every Year (EREY) status
- Support and participate in club service projects
- Participate in club social activities
