Alex Stettinski is the Executive Director of the Downtown Reno Partnership (DRP), and will be giving an update on the BID/DRP in particular during COVID-19, and an overview of Downtown developments in the pipeline.



Alex has an extensive background in the improvement district, chamber of commerce, and tourism/destination marketing industries and served in several leadership roles for the past 20 years. He was executive director of the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce and Vice President of Operations & Strategic Planning at Visit West Hollywood.
