School Juniors and Seniors. It is a joint effort between Districts 5180 and 5190 and it is held at Grizzly Ranch which is near Portola, California. The camp is 5 days and is led by two professional Trainers, Dean and Rochelle Whellams. Volunteer Rotarians serve as Camp Directors and Camper Leaders. Our club sponsored ten students this year and the full cost is paid for by our club through our Reno Rotary Foundation.

The focus of the camp is developing Communication Skills, Personal Qualities, Leadership and Problem Solving Strategies. The students go through many leadership and team building activities including a ropes course, a STEP profile thinking exercise, building a bicycle which is later donated to a child from the local boys and girls club.
