A former history teacher and WCSD principal, Patti's family came to Nevada shortly after statehood. She is a graduate of Carson High School, and received both her bachelors and master's degrees from UNR. Retired from her Principalship for Washoe County School District, and being quite aware of the lack of information on Nevada women readily available to the general public, Patti plunged into a '2nd career' working with the NWHP in conducting oral histories and collecting other types of information on women throughout the state. Her daughter Chelsea, is a speech pathologist in Carson City.


