Julia is the newly appointed Behavioral Health Administrator for Washoe County. The Board of County Commissioners has designated behavioral health as a key strategic priority for the County. This new position

was created in the Office of the County Manager to facilitate regional efforts to improve behavioral health outcomes in Washoe County. Most recently Julia was the Director of Programs and Projects for the Washoe County Health District where she led strategic planning and oversaw performance management efforts, collaborated to create and implement community health improvement plans, developed and supported health equity initiatives, as well as provided oversight to accreditation and special projects for the health district.

Julia's public service includes five years serving in the Nevada Legislature as a State Senator where she was the Assistant Majority Leader and chaired the Senate Committee on
