About the Book

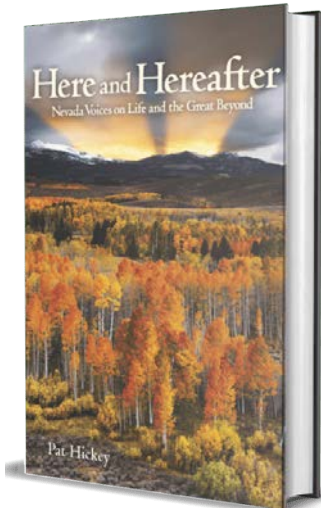
