Week 1: June 18 – 23

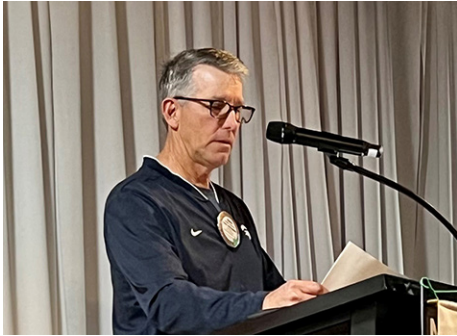
Week 2: June 25 – June 30
