Monday's Program Pat Hickey

What Notable Nevadans have to say about life and the beyond



Pat Hickey's Irish ancestors immigrated to the Carson Valley and Lake Tahoe in the 1870s. Pat wrote about growing up there in: "Tahoe Boy: A Journey Back Home." Pat has worked in Nevada media for the past 30 years doing a syn-

dicated radio report on Nevada politics, a columnist for both the Nevada Appeal and the Reno Gazette Journal, and served as the Editor of the Nevada Journal for the Nevada Policy Research Institute.

Pat served a total of eight years in the Nevada Assembly, including being the Minority Leader during the 2013 Legislative Session. Following his retirement from the Legislature, Brain Sandoval appointed Pat to the State Board of Education.

An original sponsor of charter school legislation, Pat served as the Executive Director of the Charter School Association of Nevada. He currently also serves on the Board of the Guinn Center, that recently has become a part of UNR.
