ance and investments and in church and community volunteer work.

After retiring in 2004, they moved to Pahrump, NV for the sunshine, warmer weather, and less taxes.

In 2004 they also joined an international mission organization as volunteers doing development and promotional work in the U.S.A. and assisting with projects in Africa and Asia.

In January 2017, they joined Global Hope Network Intl (GHNI) as Partner Development staff in the Western USA. They work with existing and potential new donors to assist them in partnering with GHNI projects and staff around the world. They travel primarily in the western USA and lead trips to visit overseas GHNI projects.

This year Guy and Jan will be assisting with a GHNI conference for emerging nations at the U.N. in Geneva and Guy will also be leading teams of people interested in GHNI work to India and Nepal.
