Chas is a civil engineer by profession and is the former CEO of Lumos & Associates, a local civil engineering, planning, surveying, and materials testing firm. He still consults occasionally for Lumos on bicycle and pedestrian projects.

Chas is active in the Carson City community. He is a founding member of Muscle Powered, Citizens for a Walkable and Bikeable Carson City, and is a recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Governor's Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board in honor of his work supporting bicyclists and pedestrians.




