Hawley and his team recently published a book on succession planning and have built a growing following on social media. Hawley's new book, *Master Planning: The Art of Exiting Your Business*, quickly reached Amazon's Best Sellers list in the category of new books on business sales and valuations.

Throughout his distinguished career, Hawley has held entrepreneurial and senior executive leadership positions at MacLean Financial Group, Heritage Bank of Nevada, and MassMutual Financial Group.
