Southwestern Uganda Water and Sanitation Hygiene Global Grant Approved!



Yahoo, The Rotary Foundation has approved our global grant "Southwestern Uganda Water and Sanitation Hygiene in Schools" in the amount of <u>\$172,469</u>! We will work with Kihihi Rotary at 10 primary schools near Bwindi and will upgrade or construct new latrines for girls, water catchment systems and distribute 1,300 reusable sanitary pad kits to young females between the age of 9 and 15.
