Club, spending his final 4 years as the Executive Director. During that time, he was recognized as the 2017 Executive Director of the Year by Boys & Girls Clubs of America, a 40 under 40 recipient by Cascade Business News, and led his agency to a Non-Profit of the Year award by the Bend Chamber of Commerce.

In 2018, Derek joined Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northern Nevada (BBBSNN) as the agency's CEO. Throughout his career, Derek has shown a deep commitment to youth issues, serving on boards for organizations such as the Shared Future Coalition, Girls on the Run, 100 Men Who Care, and the Northern Nevada RAVE Family Foundation. In 2019, he was elected as one of twelve CEO's to serve on the Nationwide Leadership Council for Big Brothers Big Sisters of America.

Under Derek's leadership, BBBSNN received a \$1.2 million capacity building grant from Lost Horse LLC, MacKenzie Scott's philanthropic organization, leading to the purchase of a new headquarters for BBBSNN in 2023. Derek has also connected with Hollywood star Jeremy Renner, collaborating on multiple projects including an episode of Rennervations on Disney+ highlighting BBBSNN's work and receiving a donation of a mobile activity center to serve under-resourced neighborhoods and communities. Most recently, BBBSNN partnered with Jeremy Renner and the Lennon Bus Project to produce a music video that 6 BBBSNN teen Littles helped write, perform, and produce, debuted at Art Town in July 2024. Derek's innovative leadership has also led to the expansion of rural program services in Douglas and Lyon County and in 2024 the launch of Big Hearts Big Homes, an initiative to remodel the homes of Littles in the community.

Derek is a 2019 graduate of the Reno + Sparks Chamber Leadership program as well as the Non-Profit Academy hosted by the Community Foundation of Western Nevada. That same year, he became a proud Big Brother to his first Little Brother, Sequel, helping him graduate high school and enroll in the Homeland Security Program at Job Corps. Derek is now matched with his second Little Brother through BBBSNN's school-based program at Glenn Duncan Elementary. Additionally, Derek was selected as a Twenty Under Forty Award Winner by the Reno Tahoe Young Professionals Network in 2022.
