Mosier provides executive support for approximately 75 faculty, thirty-five professionals and 3,500 students

at the Bachelor, Master, MBA, and PhD levels.

Mosier serves on the International Advisory Board for the SGH Warsaw School of Economics and is a frequent contributor to global business school accreditation activities of AACSB.

Mosier, previously at Oklahoma State University, was interim dean of Business, associate dean, Regents Service Professor, and an endowed professor. He is a former corporate attorney, working in the oil and gas industry and passed the State Bar Exams of Kansas, Texas, and Oklahoma. Mosier's
