

The Rotary Club of Lakeville “Service Above Self” Charitable Grant Request Form Requirements & Process

Non-profits carrying out activities and projects that support Lakeville Rotary and Rotary International’s areas of focus are welcome to apply for a Rotary Club of Lakeville grant. The Foundation Committee shall determine the allocation of grant requests.

REQUIREMENTS/PROCESS

- Organization must be a non-profit, preferably with a 501(c)3 number
- These are local grant requests and are intended to serve the community and people of Lakeville
- Requests for local grants outside of Lakeville are allowed as long as the Lakeville community will benefit from the request
- Grant requests must be for a specified need, not general operating expenses
- Activities/projects are encouraged to support at least one of these focus areas:

Rotary International - Seven Areas of Focus

- Peacebuilding and Conflict Prevention
- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene
- Maternal and Child Health
- Basic Education and Literacy
- Community Economic Development
- Protecting Our Environment

Rotary Club of Lakeville - Additional Areas of Focus

- Veteran and Senior Services
 - Youth Education and Workforce Development
 - Public Safety Support
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- The Foundation Grant Committee meets monthly to review grant requests
 - If your grant request is not received before the meeting, we will hold it over until the next monthly meeting
 - You will be notified of the committee’s decision by email following the meeting
