MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Alison Bischofberger, the Associate Director for Community Beyond Violence (CBV) and Kristen Dees, a board member, spoke to our club today about their organization and the positive impact that they are able to make throughout the area.

The Mission Statement of CBV "... is to offer resources for building healthy relationships and to work with community partners to provide services for healing the effects of interpersonal violence."



For example, last year they were able to aid with 59 housing assistance actions, 212 domestic violent restraining orders, and 37 sexual assault cases. They also received over 700 calls on their crisis care line.

CBV can aid in multiple ways! They can provide someone in need with therapist referrals, lodging, food, clothing, limited transportation, and a variety of legal services. They work with a local Family Law Attorney who provides 30-minute individual legal aid appointments. They also offer access to in-person and virtual support groups that are facilitated by certified peer counselors.



A new program was highlighted. It includes a partnership between Dignity Health and the Grass Valley Police Department. With their combined efforts, a Sexual Response Team will be constructed.

Please reach out to CBV if you or anyone that you know of may need their assistance. They are available to provide support through in-person counseling, help via a 24/7 crisis line, or/and help through text or a web chat.


