The Food Bank was founded in 1986. Their Mission : To Feed People. Nicole shared the following facts: People need to have full meals, healthy ones! The bank receives food from various sources. The Bank has a warehouse w/ USDA Commodities, refrigeration to keep things cold. Provides food for those in need. It receives donations from various community resources. They provide snacks for children who would not have food in the morning and free nutritious lunches for those same children. They provide outreach programs for Seniors.
