just under four years. They specialize in design, sales, and servicing of solar systems. Brandon discussed the benefits of solar, PGE's Tier rating system, and the changes and challenge his industry is facing. He pointed out that the average residential system should pay for itself within five to ten years and the equipment should last for

30 years. The average commercial system should pay for itself within three to six years with similar life expectancy. Commercial financing can be obtained through Tri Counties Bank, check out their Solar Energy Financing Program (not a shameless plug).

California Solar is currently installing the system for Briar Patch. The floor was opened up for questions and discussion. If you are in the market for a solar system, reach out to Brandon Davis for a free solar analysis.
