of data to viewers. They employ 240 people in 5 locations worldwide and have been in operation over 17 years. Finding good talent has been their major focus in a hugely critical engineering culture. Candidates for employment look to Nevada County and scrutinize what our community has to offer in regards to education for their families, heritage and cultural activities, and the community's score on crime......they even read The Union. Dan commented particularly on the pot issue here, declining enrollment in our schools, lack of ethnic areas,
